Insects and their relatives, spiders, ticks, and mites, are excellent model systems for understanding the biological world. Entomologists study insects from the cellular level to the ecosystem level of organization, in areas such as evolution, ecology, physiology, morphology, systematics, toxicology, behavior, and genetics. There is also a significant applied component to entomology which addresses important economic, public health, and environmental impacts of insects. The Department of Entomology is rated in the top five nationally and is the only entomology program in Ohio. The entomology major provides students with a basic background in the biological sciences together with in-depth study of insect biology and applied entomology. Within the major, there are opportunities for students to specialize in areas such as acarology, apiculture, pest management, arthropod physiology, systematic entomology, and toxicology.
